



...Sea turtles dig the dark!



KEEP IT SHIELDED

Close your curtains or blinds after dark and use shielded, cut-off fixtures or vegetation to cover lightbulbs and direct light downward.



KEEP IT LOW

Use downlighting, low mounting height, and low bulb wattage.



KEEP IT LONG

Use red, amber, yellow, or warm lightbulbs and color filters.
Sea turtles and other wildlife are less disturbed by these longer wavelengths of light!

Beachfront lighting, skyglow, and other forms of light pollution discourage nesting sea turtles, disorient hatchlings, and disrupt nocturnal wildlife
