

APPLICATION REVIEW

We will review your application and schedule an on-site meeting with you.





SITE VISIT & PLAN

We will verify your responses, answer questions, and develop a plan of action with specific areas where you can improve.





FOLLOW UP & CERTIFICATION

We will calculate which tier you qualify for and issue you a digital and framed certificate to display.





ANNUAL REVIEW

We will annually review your certification to help you continue to improve and move up in tiers.

Program Goals

Overall our program strives to meet the following goals for a more sustainable Nosara (items in bold are required). You'll receive a printable checklist with detailed goals specific to each certification category when you apply.





ENERGY

- Track and reduce energy use
- Use energy saving appliances and light bulbs
- Use smart features to save energy
- Use solar energy
- Regularly maintain appliances



WASTE

- Up to date on payments to the Recycling Center
- Separation of recyclables and organic waste
- Proper containment and disposal of all waste
- Use paper conservation measures
- Properly dispose of all trash
- ✓ No single-use plastics



LEADERSHIP

- ✓ Pay minimum wage and provide benefits to employees
- ✓ Promote sustainability, organize and host "green" events
- Support local NGOs

Important Definitions













LED - light emitting diode, high-efficiency lighting

T5/T8 - High-efficiency models of flurorescent or LED lighting

Eco-friendly products - cause less harm to human health and the environment when compared to other competing products and services. Look for products that are biodegradable, pH balanced, EcoLogo Certified, Green Seal Certified, etc.

Plastics PET1, HDPE2, LDPE4 - On the bottom of every plastic item is a number in the middle of a triangle that signifies what type of plastic it is. Polyethylene Terephthalate, High-Density Polyethylene, and Low-Density Polyethylene (PET1, HDPE2, and LDPE4), are the three types of plastic that can be recycled by the Nosara Recycling Center.

Plastics PVC3, PP5, PS6, 7 - On the bottom of every plastic item is a number in the middle of a triangle that signifies what type of plastic it is. Polyvinyl Chloride, Polypropylene, Polystyrene and other miscellaneous plastics (PVC3, PP5, PS6, and 7) are all plastics that cannot be recycled in Nosara and end up in a landfill, the environment or ocean.

Energy Star - an international symbol that identifies products as the top efficiency performer in their category. Energy Star is a government/industry partnership that makes it easy for businesses and consumers to save money and protect the environment.

Septic VS. Wastewater treatment system - Septic tanks use basic gravity to separate solid and liquid waste, whereas wastewater treatment systems use electric and mechanical components to introduce aerobic bacteria and/or aeration which break down the waste in the liquid. A sewage treatment plant is essentially a more sophisticated and advanced version of a septic tank that actually treats the wastewater, therefore producing a higher quality of effluent.

Grease Traps - A grease trap is a plumbing device designed to intercept most greases and solids before they enter a wastewater disposal system. The grease trap should be cleaned out when it reaches a quarter of its capacity.

Sourced Locally and Sustainably - Items that are sourced locally are from within the country, region, or district. The more locally sourced an item is, the lower environmental impact. Items that are sourced sustainably are from businesses aligned with the goals outlined in this certification program.
